Lake Usage Policy
Date Approved: 1.26.2026

Purpose:

It is important to note that all bodies of water within Bonita National are natural habitats to wildlife living within the community. Florida water areas have numerous wildlife including the American Alligator. Please remember to always observe your surroundings.

Scope:

This policy applies to all residents, guests, and visitors who live within the boundaries of the Bonita National community.

Policy Statement:

Any person entering near any ponds or other water bodies within the community shall be responsible for his or her own personal safety and shall assume all risks of personal injury, including death, relating to such use. The Bonita National Homeowner's Association shall not in any way be a guardian or insurer of safety relating to the presence or use of any water bodies or features within the community and shall not be held responsible for any personal injury or death, property damage, or any other loss due to, arising out of, or related to use of such water features for any purpose.

Prohibited Use:

Swimming in the lakes is prohibited. No one is allowed to put anything into the water. Boats, canoes, kayaks, paddleboards and any other watercraft may not be used on any lake in the community. This also included any remote-controlled water or air vehicle.

The lakes are property of the CDD and all plant life along the banks are protected. No one is allowed to spray or remove any plants especially littorals plants, planted to protect against bank erosion. No one is allowed to discard any yard clipping into the lakes.

Fishing:

No fishing is allowed from lake banks that are on any part of the golf course, common areas or residential properties. Fish shall not be removed from the communities' bodies of water or transferred to other lakes within the community. No outside fish, or otherwise wildlife caught outside the community can be released into any lake in the community. Cast netting is prohibited, members shall not trespass on private residential property or enter upon any homeowner's personal property or easement to access community lakes. No fishing is allowed from lake banks that are on any part of the golf course. Fish shall not be removed from the communities' bodies of water or transferred to other lakes within the community. No outside fish, or otherwise wildlife caught outside the community can be released into any lake in the community.
